

Universal Credit

Universal credit is paid monthly and therefore the guest will likely have to wait between four and five weeks for their first payment.

Citizens Advice are a good point of advice and support and they have a useful helpline.

The Guests will be entitled to £200/p/p emergency payment on arrival, but usually it takes at least 6 weeks for the Universal Credit payments to start coming in. Details to follow as soon we have them.

Working parents on Universal Credit can get up to 80% of their childcare costs reimbursed. If they need more help they can ask their job coach about the flexible support fund, a grant that doesn't have to be paid back, or an advance on their next Universal Credit payment.
